These visitors were also very impressed by the strong relationships between staff and students, the consistently high quality of teaching across the lessons they saw, and the quality of resources our students have to use (exercise books and assessment prep books).

Marcus Fysh MP visited on Friday afternoon, to see and hear about the work we have been doing to improve our school, which he had heard much about already. It was very pleasing for me to learn that our school is being spoken about positively. We discussed Holyrood's ambition to step beyond the school gates and further into the local community, which he was keen to support.

Last week was predominantly about Remembrance. Our students all attended a special series of events to draw their attention to the sacrifices others made so that they can have the freedoms they have today. 




