



COVID-19 Behaviour Policy

The school will:

- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's class have tested positive for COVID-19 as this will mean your child will need to self-isolate for 10 days.
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- If children do not socially distance outside of school then the school reserves the right not to allow them access in order to maintain the continued safety of all children and staff.

Parents will:

- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will self-isolate for 10 days as a family, I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- My child will need to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will reinforce with my child the importance of social distancing both during the school day and outside of school
- If my child puts others at risk by not following social distancing guidance he/she will be sent home.

Students will:

- Adhere to the social distancing rules in whilst in school;
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell;
- Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it);
- Remain within my year group bubble and remain in the social areas specified for my year group at break and lunch times.
- Sanitise my hand frequently and when entering and exiting classrooms;
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others;
- Wear a face mask within classrooms and while inside when moving between classrooms
- Follow these expectations and know that if I don't, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
