Students are required to build upon the knowledge, understanding and skills from GCSE and develop in-depth personal studies, referencing textile artists, context and techniques.

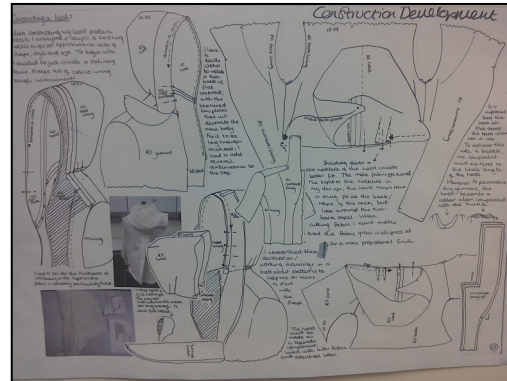
You will be looking into materials and applications, classification of materials including investigating and testing, Technical and Smart Textiles and core principles of garment manufacture.
