Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to advise that the RS Department will be taking the whole of Year 8 on a Humanities Multicultural Curriculum tour of Exeter on Thursday 27th June 2019. There will be no charge for this excursion. This is a fantastic opportunity for all students to investigate the diverse groups within the local community. They will investigate a variety of religious, geographical and historical influences on culture.

The trip will take place during Academy hours. During the day all students will visit three locations: Exeter Mosque, the Ramm Museum and Exeter Cathedral. At each location the students will experience a variety of learning activities including tours of the buildings and meeting religious leaders.

On the day students should be in the Academy uniform. There are also requirements of etiquette when visiting places of worship, to show respect for the beliefs of others. To enter the Mosque students will need their legs and arms covered, so we would ask that they bring their Academy Blazer and that girls either wear trousers or tights with a knee length skirt, as well as something to cover their hair, such as a light weight scarf.

We have arranged both wet weather and sunshine areas for eating lunch, and students should bring a packed lunch and drink with them. We will, however, be walking from each location and would, therefore, recommend that each student brings with them suitable wet weather clothing or an umbrella.
